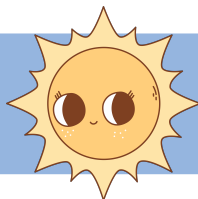

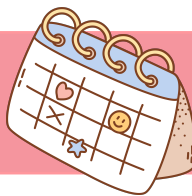

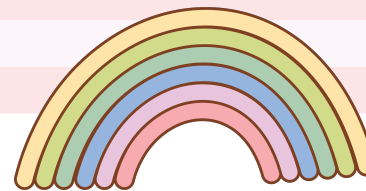

1. PTO Dues & T-Shirts

We appreciate your support! Join the PTO today and be a part of our vibrant community of parents, caregivers, teachers and administration, working together as a Kehillah (community). With paid membership dues, you will receive a Shabbat shirt for your child to wear on Fridays and show off their school spirit!

So, what do dues support?

Your \$36 PTO dues help to offset the cost of our PTO programming and events, including "We Love you Wednesday" (our monthly teacher appreciation program), all-school playdates and the week of National Teacher Appreciation (when we get to shower our teachers and staff with treats). Your dues do not cover these full costs, but they do help our PTO to provide these events and programming. Your child's Shabbat shirt is provided as a thank you for your support! If your child won't wear this shirt, no worries! You can join PTO and simply indicate that no t-shirt is needed. Your first high quality, soft cotton Shabbat shirt is included when you pay your PTO dues. Additional child shirts are offered at the cost of \$10. Adult shirts are offered at the cost of \$18.

All order forms and money are due 1 week prior to delivery date.

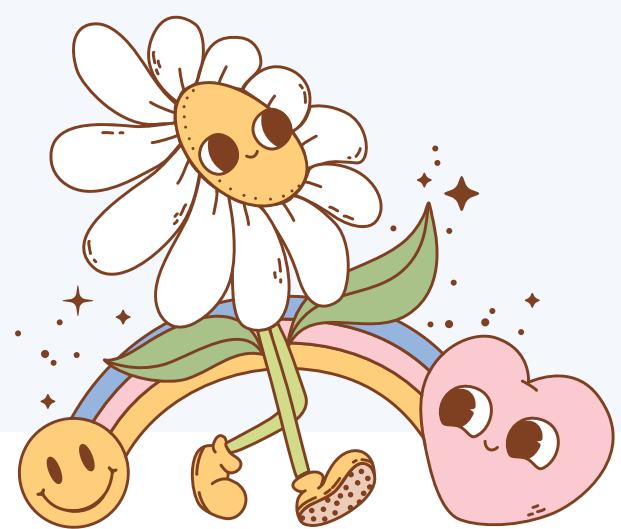
